Labour are letting our schools down



Lib Dem Cllr Liz Phillips raised concerns about the council's contractor Babcock, after it was revealed that almost 15% of our schools are now in special measures following their two years overseeing school improvement.

Labour's Cabinet member described the council's risk analysis programme for schools as 'a work in progress', and said

that the council's priority had been savings of £2m. from the contract.

Focus Team member Matt Lake says: "In Waltham Forest we are now on our fourth Labour cabinet member for Children's Services in just over two years. Perhaps if someone with a bit of experience had taken responsibility for more than a few months we wouldn't be in this situation."

The following departments have achieved some significant results: Maths -76% A*-C, 19% A*-A Additional Science -80% A*-C Biology -100% A*-C Chemistry -95% A*-C Physics -100%Art -81% A*-C, 33% A*-A History -70% A*-C, 23% A*-A English Language -92% A*-C, English Literature -93% A*-C, Drama -95% A*-C, 58% A*- A French -94% A*-C, 50% A*-A PE -79% A*-C, 12% A*-A ICT -100% A*-C, 64% A*-A

The most able students achieved very well, with almost 20% of every entry achieving an A*-A grade.
